Secondary tones of Tone 1 (pretonic)

Tone 1 level

each pretonic foot has level tone; pretonic feet at same height (before medium fall), stepping up (before wide fall), stepping down (before narrow fall) (KEY (FORCE): neutral) (examples: previous slide)

Tone 1 bouncing each pretonic foot 'bounces' (down and up) often with 'wide' tonic (KEY (FORCE): forceful)

Tone 1 listing pretonic resembles sequence of tone 3 + tone 3 (...)


